



Flagstone & Slabs

Colours

Limberlost Tan is a consistent light colour, with few imperfections for a modern yet warm impression.

Limberlost Brown is a consistent deeper colour than the Tan, a compact stone that displays nature's design of fossils and vegetation captured in the stone.

Limberlost Grey, when finished looks close to a cobalt or slate with nature's designs showing through. An unfinished version echoes Italian Travertine but in a grey colour.

Limberlost Eramosa is lighter than most of the renowned tiger stripes from the area; nature's beauty is richly displayed in the stripe of this stone or in the swirls and paisleys when fleuri cut.

Tolerances

Stone is cut within 1/8th of an inch tolerance. The nature of the stone is such that not all products can be manufactured to meet such a tolerance. Broken edge faces are are not manufactured within the tolerance 100 % of the time.

Finishes

All stone is left natural, or sandblasted or flamed using proven techniques that enhance the stone.
